

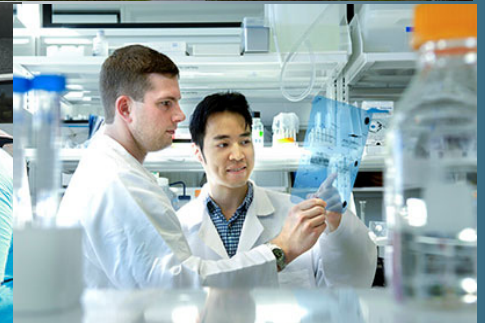

# DEFINITIONS

**Full-time status (FULL\_PART\_STATUS):** Full-time status is defined using Time Status of Full-Time in Banner (Source: Banner Form = SFAREGS, Banner Table = SFBETRM.SFBETRM\_TMST\_CODE, Banner ODS Table = ACADEMIC\_STUDY.CURRENT\_TIME\_STATUS) and is typically defined as enrollment of 12 or more credit hours in the fall or spring term for Undergraduate, Law and Medical Students and enrollment of 9 or more credit hours for all other Graduate students. However, students taking fewer credit hours may also be considered full-time in other circumstances, such as when participating in co-ops or certain field experiences and exchange programs. This definition of full-time was adopted by the University Analytics Working Group in October of 2021. IR reports published prior to that time used a credit-hour based definition of full-time, and therefore, may differ slightly from the historical data reported.

**International:** The terms international, non-resident alien and foreign are used interchangeably to refer to a person who is not a citizen or national of the United States, is in the US on a visa or temporary basis and does not have the right to remain indefinitely (IPEDS). In October 2021, the Institutional Research, Registrar, Student Success, CISP, and Enrollment Operations Offices agreed to identify these students as those with any Visa Type on file or a Residency code of “I” or “F”. This definition is slightly different than what Institutional Research used previously. Although the impact is minimal, historical IR reports with data regarding international students as well as race/ethnicity and URM students may differ from more current reports.

**Race/Ethnicity (RACE\_ETHNI):** Effective Fall 2021, the derived field calculation for IPEDS Race Ethnicity will use Visa type and Residency to identify non-resident students and match with our definition of International student. This definition was adopted by the University Analytics workgroup in October 2021.

**Age:** The University Analytics workgroup agreed to exclude outlier ages of <10 or >100 from age calculations (e.g., mean, median, etc.) or age categorizations in October 2021.

**Ohio Resident:** includes Ohio resident, Monroe county resident, Forever Buckeye and non-confirmed students.

**FTE=** Number of students with Enrollment status of Full time + 1/3 (Number of students with enrollment status of Part time).

**ACT Composite:** is as of census day and is super scored. The ACT data in this report may be slightly different than in previous reports, which pulled ACT from live Banner ODS and were as of the date on which the data were pulled.

**Ethnic Minority:** Includes all IPEDS race/ethnicity categories except for white, international and unknown.

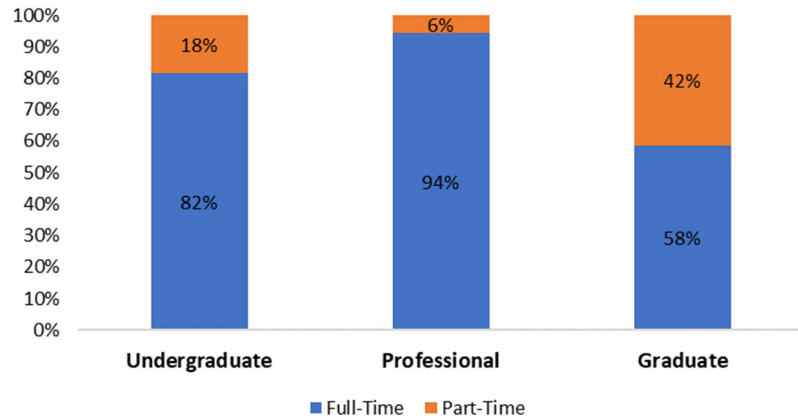

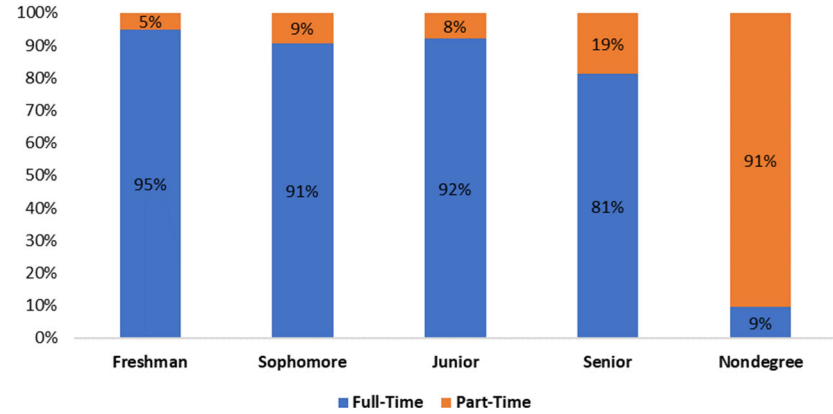
**ENROLLMENT BY FULL-TIME AND PART-TIME**

For Fall Semester 2016 through 2021

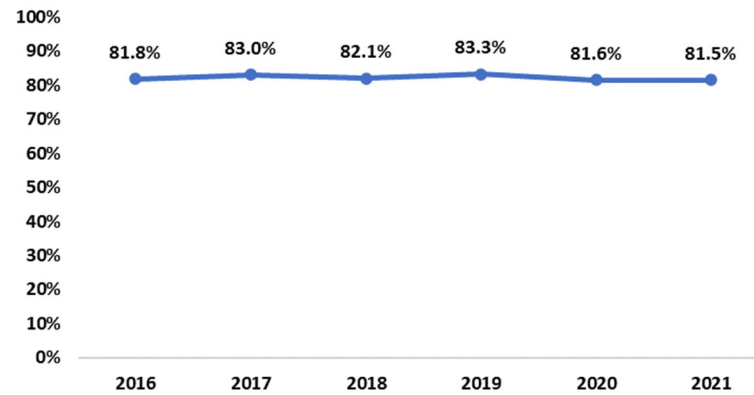
**Enrollment by Course Load and Student Level (2021)**

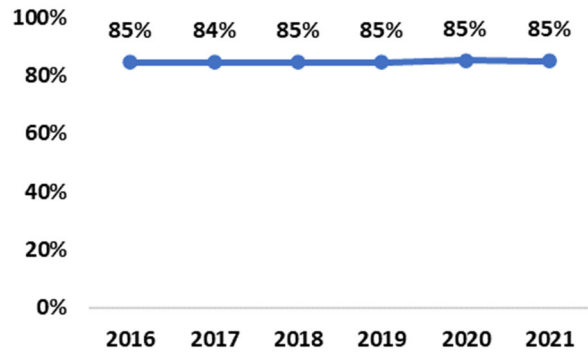
# ENROLLMENT BY OHIO RESIDENCY AND STUDENT LEVEL

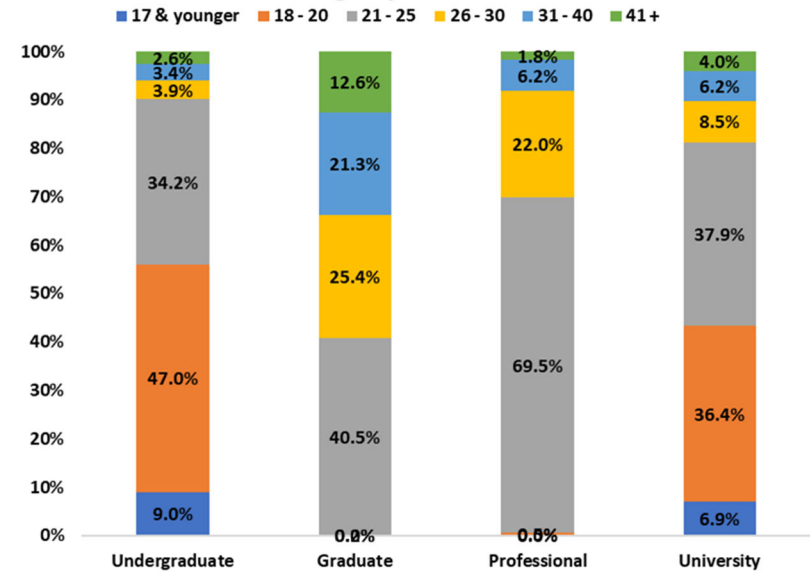
# ENROLLMENT BY AGE

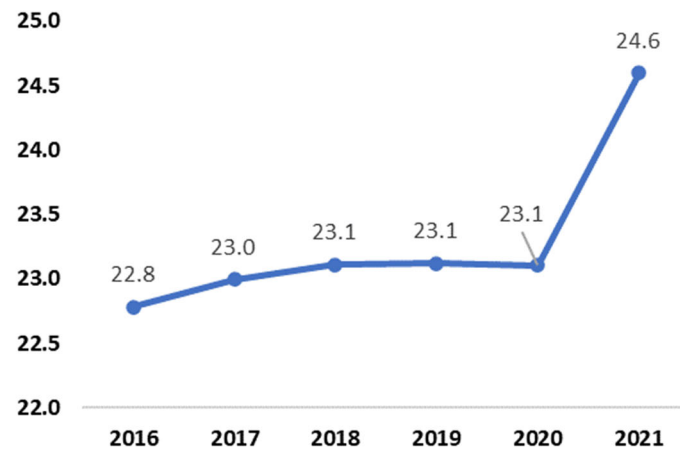

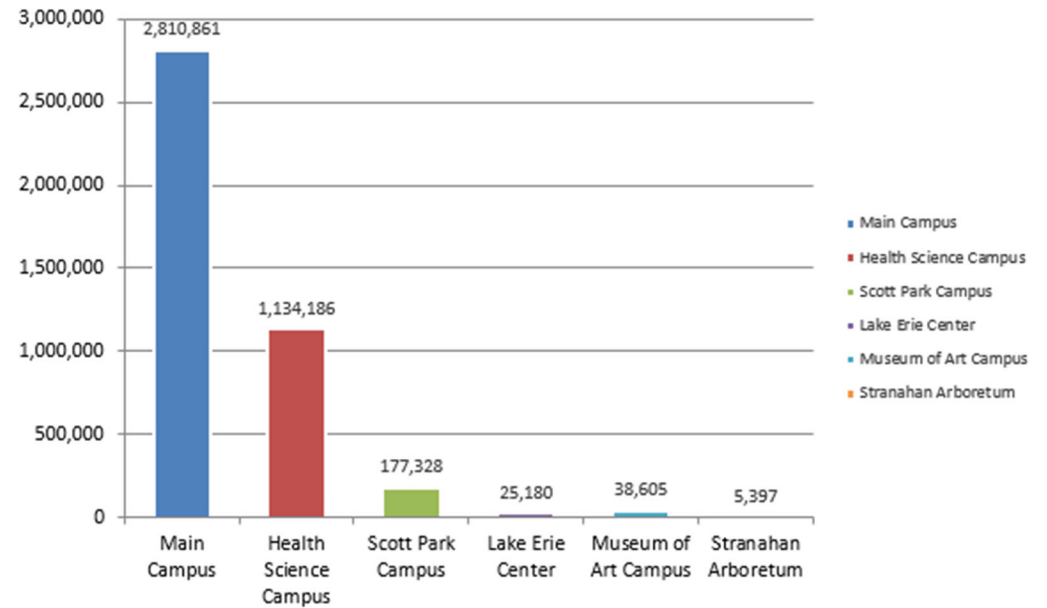

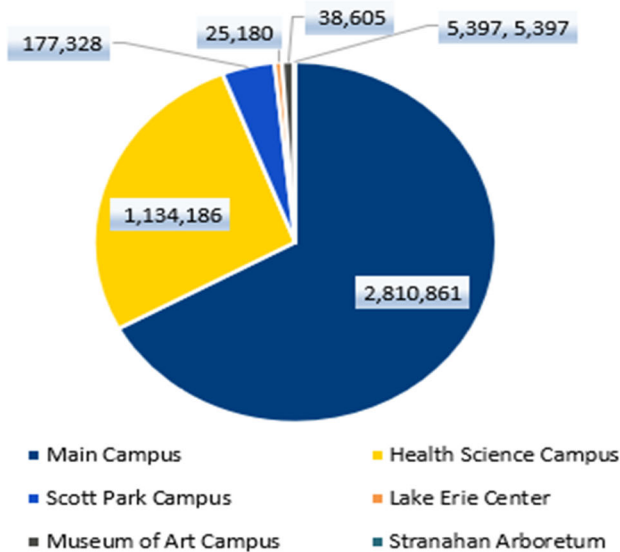

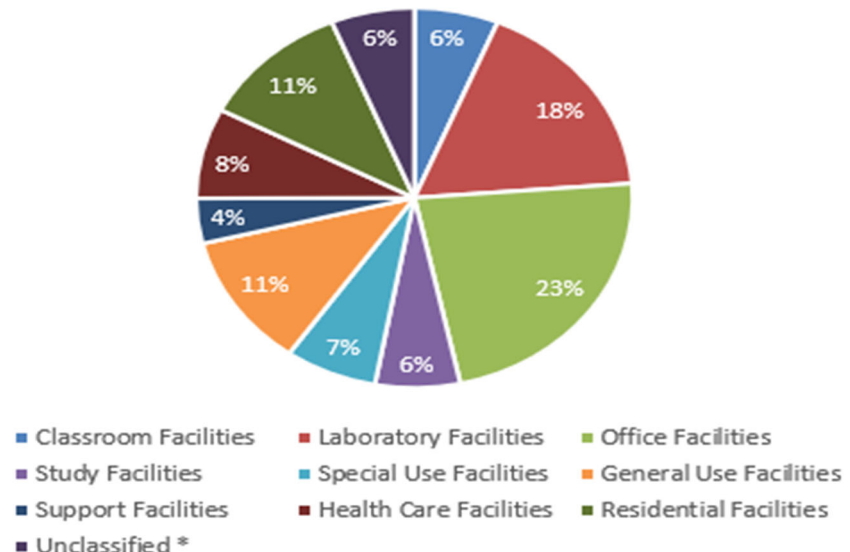

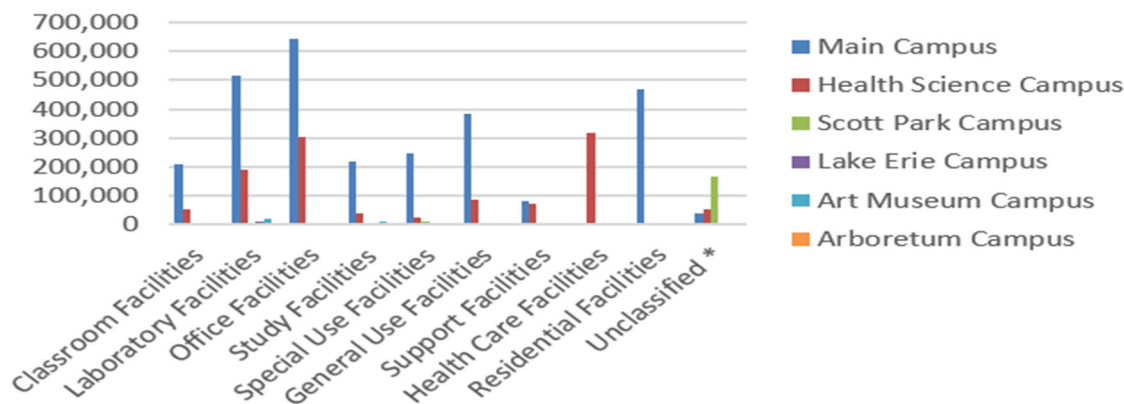

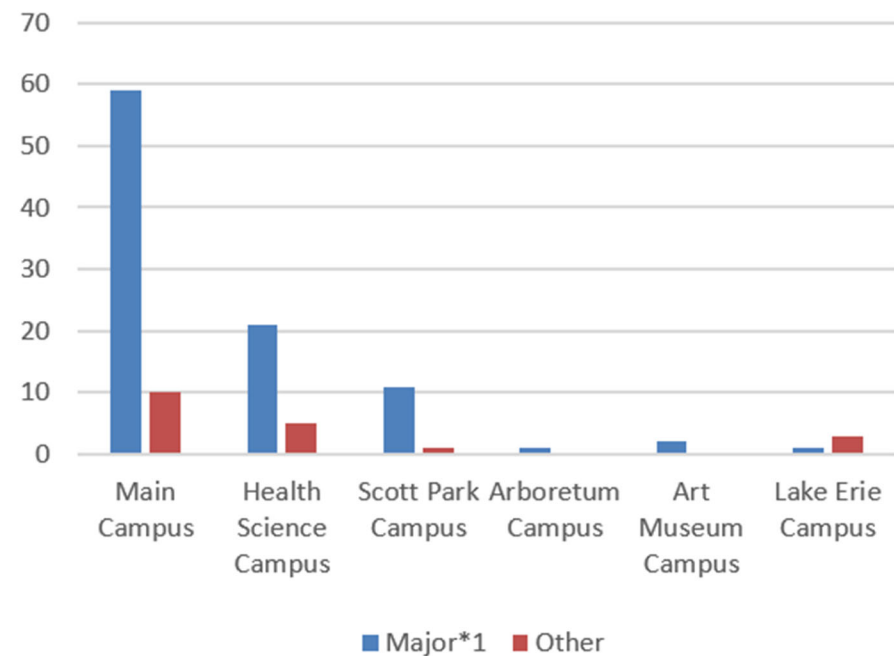

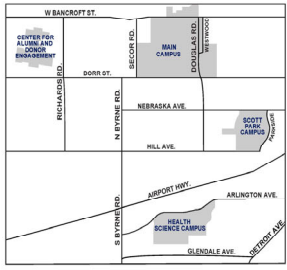

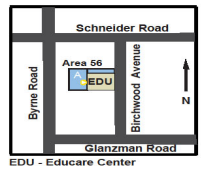
